

## Formal Consultation Responses TRO 23-1

Response	Consultation response content
1	We received your letter this morning regarding proposed parking alterations at the junction of Lower Sean and Hydean Way. I fear all these yellow lines you intend to add will only force people to park on the opposite side of the road, I therefore request you look again and consider my concerns on this matter and not just the residents at the bottom of Lower Sean. I look forward to you reply.
2	I have just read your 4 proposals for Lower Sean & I would like to register my support of all said proposals. I have lived here for over xx yrs., & the near misses of children nearly being hit by cars would make your head spin. We have been asking for so long over many years for these yellow lines, that I as well as others will welcome them with open arms, & I would also like to say a big thank you, to you all, for hearing & registering our concerns.
3	Both my partner and I are in favour and full agreement with the Double Yellow Lines being put on the junctions of Hydean Way and Lower Sean. The parking of vehicles at school drop off and pick up is frightening and it is a wonder that someone has not been hurt or killed. If you try to drive out at this time you cannot see what is coming in either direction.
4	In reference to the above - yellow lines at the junction to Lower Sean, I live at number xxx and fully support this proposal. On numerous occasions when trying to get out of my road at school pick-up and drop-off times, I have encountered dangerous situations. Because of the way that parents and carers park on the corners, it is impossible to see if children are behind them and likely to step out into the road to cross. Also getting out of the road is always a challenge at these times because of being unable to see approaching traffic from either the left or the right. I have lived here for over ten years and seen the situation getting progressively worse. It is only a matter of time before there will be an incident, either vehicle collisions or even worse, an injury to a child. Please give very careful consideration to going ahead with this scheme for the reasons outlined above.
5	I received your notice of application for double yellow lines on the bend of Lower Sean / Hydean Way. I am very happy about this. For years we have had issues on that bend, and we are the only road down Hydean Way that doesn't have double yellows, yet we are a main junction for children going to three nearby schools. I have seen near misses due to people parking so badly on the bend without consideration which is particularly bad during school pick up and drop off. I fully support this and hope the consultation is fruitful. Please do let me know if there is anything else you need to record my support.
6	Having lived in Lower Sean for over xx years we are pleased that, at last, we are going to have restrictions for parking in our road. As you must be aware, we have lived with the inconvenience and the dangers at certain times of the day. We wholly support this step forward in making this a safer environment for all residents and pedestrians.
